

# THE VALUE OF ADMIT



ADMIT completers were less than half (45 percent) as likely to be convicted of a new charge as a group of similar individuals released at the same time.

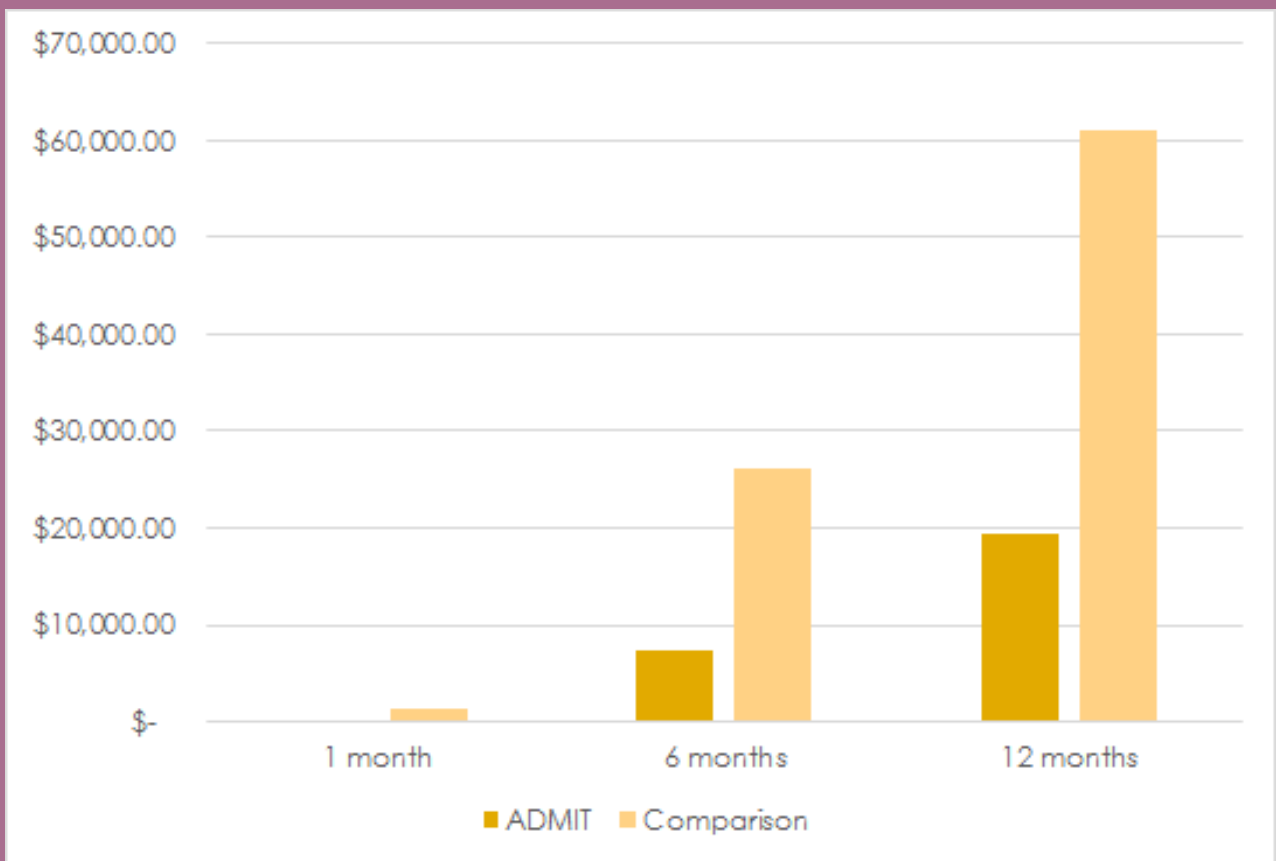


Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office saved over half a million dollars in jailbed costs by allowing ADMIT clients to be treated in the community.

Post-release, ADMIT completers continue to cost Arapahoe County less than a group of similar individuals.

## MENTAL HEALTH GAINS

In program year 2016 - 2017, ADMIT completers demonstrated significant improvement on a host of psychological well-being measures such as the *Modified Coping Self-Efficacy Scale*, the *Brief Symptom Inventory*, and the *Beck Depression Inventory*, suggesting that they are on the way to recovery.
